

Loss of Privilege Details

The White County Ninth Grade Academy is pleased to offer the Washington, DC field trip experience for its students this year. This activity will culminate a year of studying about the different branches of the government in Civics, process skills and discoveries in Physical Science, and other content related facts and knowledge in the Fine Arts and Vocational Areas. However, our foremost goal for this trip is safety. We are willing to take with us the students who have demonstrated proper behavior during the school year. These are the rules which will govern participation in this field trip:

Students who demonstrate the following behaviors will lose their privilege to go on the Washington field trip:

1. OSS = automatic dismissal from the trip
2. ISS = dismissal from the trip after being assigned to ISS three times
3. Any student with ten or more unexcused absences or tardies may be deemed ineligible to go.
Note: The administrative staff reserves the right to evaluate attendance on a case-by-case basis.
4. Students who are not passing their academic classes (English, Math, Physical Science, Civics, and Spanish II) may be deemed ineligible to go. Grades will be reviewed at the end of February.
Note: The administrative staff reserves the right to evaluate academic eligibility on a case-by-case basis.

Loss of Privilege Waiver Form
